This year, as part of our annual **Wizard of Oz Festival**, the Judy Garland Museum will hold a talent contest for young people between the ages of six through eighteen. This means: singers, dancers, musicians, actors, magicians and comedians.

Our theme is artistry inspired by Judy Garland and *The Wizard of Oz*. This includes music from Garland's films, concert career, and hundreds of record albums. It also includes themes and songs from Oz films and Broadway shows, including: *The Wizard of Oz*, *The Wiz*, and *Wicked*.

You may perform these songs in their own style. It is suggested that "**Over the Rainbow**" not be chosen because it can be over used. GOOGLE "Judy Garland" or "The Wizard of Oz," look on YouTube, and get inspired! Songbooks are available for purchase at the museum.

WINNERS WILL RECEIVE:

- ❖ **First Prize** - \$1,000 - scholarship to be used for music, dance or educational classes, including a college fund AND a performance at the **Wizard of Oz Festival Dinner, Saturday, June 10th** at the Sawmill.
- ❖ **Second Prize** - \$500 Scholarship - to be used as above.
